### "The Bright Splendour whom the Nations Seek"

The Feast of the Epiphany is on Wednesday 6th January, but we will also be celebrating it on Sunday 3rd. The collect after communion says, "Lord God, the bright splendour whom the nations seek." This refers



to the wise men from the East, or the Magi. They represent the rest of the world outside the Jewish nation, they become a symbol for the rest of the world seeking God.

This year we have seen the "Christmas Star" which is a conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn, it was quite an amazing sight to see the two planets so close together. There has been some speculation that the star that the wise men followed was a similar conjunction. However, the point about the wise men was not so much that they saw something which everyone else could see, but they were following first and foremost something which God had revealed to them. By following the signs to Bethlehem, they made known something that most people could not see, that an ordinary baby was in the fact the Son of God

So, Epiphany is the start of a mysterious season, in which our view of God's actions in the world might be both challenged and broadened. Again, we have the idea of light shining in the darkness, and the representatives of the nations, make their way to the light of the world.
